**Objective** The creation of biodiversity and the formation of green spaces along the quarry area

**Context** Since 1981, the Muneville Quarry has succeeded in maintaining, protecting, and developing biodiversity on its site. It has shown that, while quarry operations altered the ecosystem, they could also contribute to enriching them through various initiatives and long-term partnerships with local associations and players.

**Actions** Generation of heath areas around the hardrock quarry, the preservation of Red-List orchids, the monitoring of invasive plant species, the creation of biodiversity refuges and the formation of green areas along its road network.

**Result** Increase and preservation of fauna biodiversity and Red-list orchids.  
Continuous monitoring on the aforementioned biodiversity.
